STEP 1Cut all the pieces as directed above.

CARD #1 INSTRUCTIONS

MEASUREMENTS

Old Olive Card Base: 8 1/2" x 5 1/2"

scored at 4 1/4".

Pumpkin Pie: 3 1/2" X 5"

Basic White: 23/4" X41/4", plus scrap

DSP: 4" X 5 1/4"



STEP 2

Stamp the cornstalks, pumpkins and hens using Old Olive, Crushed Curry, Pumpkin Pie, and Pecan Pie ink as shown.

Stamp the sentiment on a scrap of Basic White using Old Olive ink.





CARD #1 INSTRUCTIONS (CONTINUED)

STEP 3

Die cut the Pumpkin Pie piece using the 2nd largest die from the Textured Notes Dies. Die cut the sentiment using the smallest die from the Textured Notes Dies.



STEP 4

Layer and attach the Designer Series Paper, Pumpkin Pie piece, and Stamped image to the card front. Tie a bow with Linen Thread and attach with a glue dot..



STEP 5

Attach the sentiment with Stampin' Dimensionals.







CARD #2 INSTRUCTIONS

MEASUREMENTS

Cherry Cobbler card base: 8-1/2" \times 5-1/2", score at 4 1/4"

Cherry Cobbler: scrap with adhesive

sheet attached to back

Designer Series Paper: 4" X 5 1/4" Basic White: 4 1/4" X 4 1/4" AND a

scrap

STEP 1

Cut and score pieces as directed above.



STEP 2

Using Cherry Cobbler, Pecan Pie, Garden Green, and Tuxedo Black Momento Ink, Stamp the tractor, wagon, trees, and tires.

Stamp the sentiment with Cherry Cobbler ink.



STEP 3

Die cut pieces as shown. For the sentiment, use the smallest die from the Textured notes die, lining up the left side as shown.



CARD #2 INSTRUCTIONS (CONTINUED)

STEP 3

Shorten the sentiment piece by lining up the right side of the die as shown.



STEP 4

Attach the DSP to the front of the Cherry Cobbler Card base. Attach the tractor, trees and wagon with liquid glue. Then attach the wheels with Stampin' Dimensionals. Tie a bow with Linen Thread and attach it with a glue dot. Attach the sentiment with Stampin' Dimensionals.







CARD #3 INSTRUCTIONS

MEASUREMENTS

Early Espresso Card stock: $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " x

5 ½", scored at 4 ¼"

Basic Beige Cardstock: 4 1/4" X 3" Designer Series Paper: 4" X 5 1/4" Pumpkin Pie Card stock: 5 1/2" X 2 1/2" Basic Black: 1 1/2" X 4 1/2", plus a scrap

with adhesive sheet on the back

Basic White: 3 1/2" X 3 1/4", and a scrap


STEP 1

Cut and score pieces as directed above.



STEP 2

Emboss the Basic Beige cardstock using the Mini Corrugated 3D Embossing Folder.



STEP 3

Use Crushed Curry, Cajun Craze, and Pumpkin Pie Ink to stamp the hay bale, hen, and banner. Stamp the sentiment using Pumpkin Pie ink.




CARD #3 INSTRUCTIONS (CONTINUED)

STEP 4

Die Cut all of the pieces as shown. Use adhesive sheet on back of the black cardstock from which you are cutting out the steering wheel / exhaust stack.

Use Paper snips to cut the sentiment.





STEP 5

Layer and attach the DSP and Basic Beige on to the Early Espresso Card base. Attach the Tractor body, wagon, wheels and haystack, and banner using liquid glue. Use mini stampin dimensionals to attach the fenders and hen. Use liquid glue to attach the sentiment.







CARD #4 INSTRUCTIONS

MEASUREMENTS

Old Olive card base: 8-1/2" 'x 5 1/2",

scored at 4" and 8" Old Olive: 3/4" X 3 1/4" Basic Beige: 3 3/4" X 5" DSP: 3 3/4" X 5 1/4" Basic White: 3 1/2" X 3"

Crushed Curry: scrap with

adhesive sheet on back if desired

STEP 1

Cut pieces as directed above.

Note: Crushed Curry scrap is not shown in the photo.



STEP 2

Use Old Olive and Crushed Curry ink to stamp the cornstalks on the DSP as shown.



STEP 3


Stamp the tractor, wheels, and seat using Garden Green, Tuxedo Black Momento, and Crushed Curry Ink.



CARD #4 INSTRUCTIONS (CONTINUED)

STEP 4

Use Paper Snips to fussy cut the tractor, and die cut the hubcaps from a piece of Crushed Curry (use adhesive sheet on the back if desired). Attach the hubcaps to the tractor wheels.



STEP 5

Stamp the cornstalks and the sentiment on the Basic Beige cardstock as shown, using Old Olive and Crushed Curry Ink.



STEP 6

Attach the stamped DSP to the card front between the 4" and 8" score lines.





CARD #4 INSTRUCTIONS (CONTINUED)

STEP 7

Line the bottom of the card up at the 1 1/2" mark on your Stampin' Trimmer. Cut a slit in the card from the 1" mark down to the 4 1/2" mark.




STEP 8

Attach Tear n' Tape to the 1/2" panel (below the 8" score line). Fold and burnish the score lines using your bone folder.



STEP 9

Attach a Stampin' Dimensional to the 3/4" X 3 1/4" piece of Old Olive card stock, leave the backing on the dimensional for now.



CARD #4 INSTRUCTIONS (CONTINUED)

STEP 10

Slide the strip (the mechanism) into the slit on the front of the card as shown, sliding it all the way to the left end of the slit that was created. Then holding it in place, flip the card over.....



STEP 11

Attach Tear n' Tape to the back of the mechanism as shown.



STEP 12

Remove the backing from the tear n' tape to attach the stamped Basic Beige piece to the mechanism, being sure the top edge of the Basic Beige and the Old Olive are aligned.



CARD #4 INSTRUCTIONS (CONTINUED)

STEP 13

Using the 13/4" circle punch, create a "finger hole" on the right side of the card. DON'T punch the basic beige layer.



STEP 14

Use a small hole punch to punch a hole in the Basic Beige piece. You will loop a ribbon through this in Step 16 so the recipient will know to pull the card out.



STEP 15

Remove the tear n' tape backing, and fold the card, enclosing the pull out mechanism inside. Remove the backing from the Stampin' Dimensional and attach the back wheel of the tractor. This is the ONLY Stampin' Dimensional that you will use to attach the tractor, so that it can move freely when slider is pulled.



CARD #4 INSTRUCTIONS (CONTINUED)

STEP 16

Use the Old Olive Stampin' Blend marker to color the White 1/4" ribbon. Allow to dry thoroughly, then loop through the hole punched in the Basic Beige piece.
